Halloween Costume Guidelines

With Halloween approaching, here are the guidelines if you are planning on wearing a costume to school:

- **Dressing up for Halloween is voluntary.** Students and staff who prefer not to dress up may choose that option.
- Costumes must be in good taste. No references to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex or violence will be allowed. Dresses must have at least a 2" strap at the shoulder.
- Students may not have blood displayed on their clothing or makeup.
- Halloween hair dye and makeup must be applied at home. NO hair dye
 or makeup may be brought to school. Any Halloween hair dye or makeup at school will result in an Administrative
 Referral to the office.
- Hats may be worn if they are part of a costume. Hats may not be worn if they are not part of a costume.
- Full face masks are not allowed. A mask covering only the area around the eyes is acceptable.
- No weapons or look-alike weapons of any kind may be brought to school. This includes plastic, wooden or other type of sword, dagger, knife, gun, etc. Any look-alike weapon will result in an Administrative Referral to the office.
- On Halloween, the focus for the day is still on learning. While we will have fun dressing up, students are reminded that we will continue to have regular classes and instruction all day long.

Let's have a good time with dressing up. If you have a question about your costume, tell a teacher or administrator what you plan to wear and let them decide if it is appropriate. Remember to keep all costumes in good taste.



This year, these kinds of animal heads that cover the entire head are popular. Please note that these will not be allowed at school. Anything that covers the head is a safety hazard and will need to be left in the office if worn to school.

Hustlin' Wildcats 2019-2020 AAU Basketball Club WINTER SESSION ~ BOYS BASKETBALL TRYOUTS

<u>The Hustlin' Wildcats Basketball Club</u> provides an opportunity for boys that live in the <u>Whitney High</u> <u>School</u> attendance area, to improve their basketball skills in a competitive environment. <u>The WHS area</u> <u>includes the following elementary schools: Sierra, Antelope Creek, Rock Creek, Ruhkala, and Sunset</u> <u>Ranch Elementary.</u>

The Hustlin' Wildcats AAU youth club is an extension of the Whitney High School Boys Basketball **Program**. It is our goal to have ALL the boys that participate in our club be interested in playing <u>Boys</u> Basketball at Whitney High School someday.

The Hustlin' Wildcats Program will teach:

1) Offensive/defensive fundamentals

2) Offensive skill development

3) The Whitney Boys Basketball Off and Def systems

4) How to work hard and be a good teammate.

Our plan is to select <u>10-15 players per team or select 16-25 (2 separate teams) players in each grade level</u>, depending on the number of kids that try-out and the skill level of the players in that age group. This will allow us to enter 1 or 2 teams in each tournament. If there are two teams in a grade level, they will be separated by ability and experience levels.

The winter season will run from <u>November 2019 to Early March 2020</u>. All teams will practice at local RUSD elementary, Junior High or High School campuses. Games will be played in tournaments on <u>BOTH SATURDAYS AND</u> <u>SUNDAYS</u> at Hardwood Palace (Rocklin) as well as other venues in the Sacramento area. <u>Players are expected to attend</u> all practices and games to be on a team.

The Hustlin' Wildcats teams will be led by experienced coaches, under the supervision of Whitney High School Varsity Boys Basketball Coach Nick French. Coach French brings over 20 years of high school and youth basketball coaching experience and has led the Whitney Boys Basketball Program the past 6 years.

The cost to participate in the Hustlin' Wildcats program is <u>estimated to be \$275-\$300</u>. This fee includes a club fee, tourney fees and a district utility fee. This season we will also be offering basketball training sessions (included in the price) that are separate from the players normal practice times. Coach John Pichon will be offering these trainings 2 times a week (days still to be determined) for any participants in our Hustlin' Wildcats Program.

Players should attend ALL try-out sessions (if possible) so that the coaches can effectively evaluate their skill level. If a player can't attend one or both days of try-outs, <u>please let the coach know</u>. <u>Please arrive at tryouts 15 minutes early</u> to fill out the registration form and get your son checked in. Players/Parents will be contacted by e-mail in early November to let them know if they made the team.
