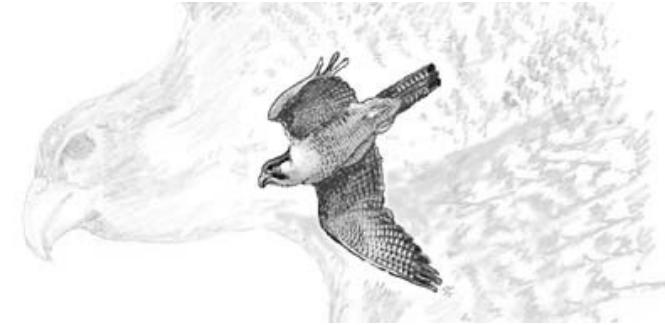

NAVIANCE is a web-based resource allowing students to not only engage in career and college readiness activities but also create a personalized educational plan which can include prospective colleges, and personal tracking tools.

Parents and family members can support their student's research by signing into NAVIANCE to encourage additional occupational research, college/university exploration and portfolio development.

Students will be able to:
