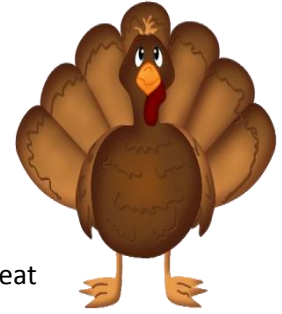
**Are you looking for fun gifts for the holidays or need wrapping paper?** Please help support GOMS and shop with our online fundraising.
