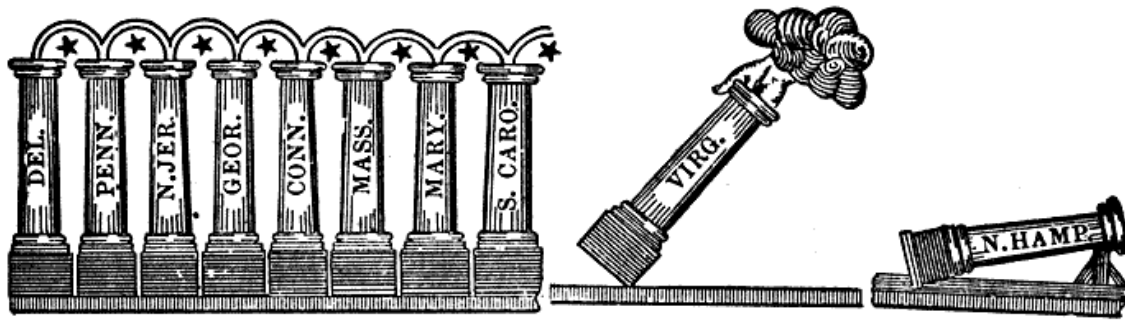
Federalists and Antifederalists
