

Republican/Federalist RECRUITMENT FLYER

Thomas Jefferson and Alexander Hamilton had differing views on many aspects of government. Because of those differences we now have political parties: Democrats and Republicans.

Directions:

1. You will be assigned one of the two leaders: Jefferson or Hamilton. You will be creating a political party flyer that will sell your assigned political party to new members..
2. Using your book and the graphic organizer find what your topic believed about the following:
 - Nature of Human Beings
 - Best Type of Government
 - Political Party and Its Ideals
 - Ideal Economy
 - View on the Constitution
3. You will use words and symbols that accurately portray each of the above five items and that will PERSUADE citizens in 1789 to join your political party.
4. You will be making a POLITICAL PARTY RECRUITMENT Flyer on Google Docs for the party of the leader you've been assigned – Hamilton or Jefferson.
5. Your flyer must have: the name of your political party and a catchy slogan,
6. Use clip art, illustrations from the internet and color to make your flyer stand out and to convince people to join your party. There must be FIVE illustrations that focus on the political party.
7. You must print this either at home or in the Computer Lab or Library here at Granite Oaks. We will be using Chrome Books and we cannot print in the class room.

Grading:

This project will be worth 40 points. The rubric on the back of this paper will be used for grading. Thirty points will be awarded for the flyer and ten points for the Hamilton/ Jefferson Comparison Chart.
