MONDAY

- 1. Start Up: Pull out and turn in one neat pile your Poetry Record Sheets. Pull out your Family Traditions Sheet for checking. Then, pull out your planners and write down this week's assignments from the flip chart.
 - a. When done get this week's vocabulary "Struct" and <u>complete parts "A" & "B" for Tues.</u> <u>11/18</u>
- 2. Review: What is "Oral Tradition?" What's a "Griot?" What was the point of the *Lion King* clip?
- 3. Introduce how newly arrived Africans view America with video clip on my webpage and discuss
- 4. In groups discuss what your group thinks is the "Rocklin Culture" to work with on Tues.
- 5. Homework: Complete Part B of Vocab "Struct" for Tues 11/18

TUESDAY

- 1. Start Up: Pull out, and show me part "B" of vocab "Struct," quietly work on part "C" (go over part "B" after checking)
- 2. Review: What was unique about Africans coming to America? How is that different from Rocklin Culture?
- 3. Intro Group Definition of "Rocklin Culture" activity to complete in class and discuss
- 4. Get a copy of the "Parts of the Paragraph: in Threes" and read it over to use this week
- 5. Get copy of the directions/ handout on the "What 3 main things would you tell a new student that they needed to do to fit in at GOMS" paragraph assignment. Begin a pre-write and 1st draft paragraph in class (out of class if absent)--you must pick three important things to help someone fit in here at GOMS and make sure you are very specific in explaining how doing so would help a new student fit in to the GOMS culture

WEDNESDAY

- 1. Start Up: Pull out your completed Pre-Writing sheet for "Fitting into GOMS" for checking, get a Chromebook, Log into rocklinusd. BYOD in the upside-down triangle, log into classroom.google.com, the paragraph assignment Google Doc provided for the assignment, and finish your typing
