Multiple Intelligences Survey Directions/Lesson

- 1. Introduce Multiple Intelligences Survey (background, why, and use of informational texts)
 - a. Do M.I. and Howard Gardner background and reference Rain Man
 - b. What does it mean to be smart? Who is smart?
 - c. Have any of you ever been told you are stupid?
 - d. Get a copy of the Multiple Intelligences handout and look at and read about the 8 different intelligences Chart on the cover. Then predict which intelligence sounds most like you. Put a check on the first page for the ONE that you think is most like you after reading the cover.
 - e. Now take the Multiple Intelligences survey making sure that you have check marks in each section. No section should have Zero check marks. Make sure that you go with your gut and not what people would want you to think or say.
- 2. Do the evaluation by looking at each section, one at a time, and placing a check mark on each of the lines in each section that sounds like you. You must have a few lines checked in every section and if you don't understand some words, ask me or look them up. When you are done with all 8 sections, total up your checks in each section to determine your dominant Multiple Intelligence (the one with the most checks and the highest score—if there's a tie, look back and pick ONE)

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
