Directions: Please: 1) read over the draft you picked; 2) go through the checklist to make sure everything is included and correct. If you find errors or something is left out, change/fix it. Make sure you look for the 3 parts of everything, the grammar and mechanics, the correct transitions, and the content/focus.

- 1) ____ Heading is used and placed correctly typed in the upper right hand corner.
- 2) ____ There is a creative title, it is in 3rd person, it is capitalized correctly (Don't capitalize conjunctions, prepositions, and articles unless they begin the title) and is centered.
- 3) ____ The title IS NOT underlined and there is a space after both the heading and title.
- 4) ____ Paragraph is left hand aligned. Then indent the (TS) by using the tab key once and begin the indented paragraph with the identifier (TS).
- 5) ____ You've included all the identifiers (TS), (1st pt.) (Ex1), (Ex 2), (2nd pt.) (Ex1), (Ex 2), (3rd pt.) (Ex1), (Ex 2), (CS).
- 6) ____ The topic sentence includes the main topic, some statement about that topic, and has "the number of reasons" in it.
- 7) ____ There are at least 11 sentences. (If not, review your notes to see what's missing.)
- 8) ____ You have three "point sentences" which all start with transition words, include the main topic in new words, and have some point about the main topic.
- 9) ____ Each point sentence is followed with at least two example/explaining sentences with the first sentence explaining the point and the remaining ones showing a specific incident that actually occurred in the writer's life that proves the point.
- 10) ____ Your last sentence is a concluding sentence that begins with a transition, restates the topic in new words, and your three points in the same order and new words.
- 11) ____ There are NO spelling errors (checked for correctly spelled words but wrong words?)
- 12) ____ There are NO capitalization errors (Checked titles of a Survey, Article, Story, Book?)
- 13) ____ Each sentence starts with a different word and the same nouns, adjectives, verbs, and adverbs are **NOT** repeated throughout the paragraph.
- 14) ____ The word "thing" is not used. If it is, replace it with a more specific word.
- 15) ____ The 2nd person pronoun "you" is not used anywhere in the writing.
