Dear GOMS Families,

We hope you had a healthy and restful winter break. Semester grades will be posted to your student's Aeries Parent Portal account by Monday, January 11th. Report cards can be printed at home via your Aeries Parent Portal account.

It is wonderful to have our students back on campus and learning during our current hybrid model. All students will continue with our hybrid system until Tuesday, January 19 when we will be switching to our everyday AM/PM schedule. The new AM/PM schedule starting on January 19th will have students divided into a morning/AM group and afternoon/PM group.

Students who are currently in our "A" hybrid group will be assigned to the morning/AM schedule.

Students who are currently in our "B" hybrid group will be assigned to our afternoon/PM schedule.

The schedule for our morning/AM group is:Monday- 8:30 a.m. to 10:51 a.m.Tuesday - Friday- 8:30 a.m. to 11:24 a.m.The schedule for our afternoon/PM group is:Monday- 11:31 a.m. to 1:52 p.m.Tuesday-Friday- 12:15 p.m. to 3:10 p.m.

We currently do not have space to move students from either the morning/AM group or afternoon/PM group. All requests to move will be placed on a list that will be reviewed.
