Principal's Message

We are pleased to have students back on campus and learning within our amazing classrooms. Students are doing an excellent job wearing masks on campus and are doing much better with social distancing. Please do keep discussing how important social distancing is with your student so that we can continue to see improvement with social distancing on our campus.

Please be sure to give us a detailed reason for your student's absence if you are calling in your student as being ill. We need specific reasons for any student feeling ill in order to ensure that we are following all COVID-19 protocols. Students suffering from the following symptoms will be placed into the COVID-19 protocol and asked to isolate at home for 10 days or receive a negative COVID-19 test and be symptom free for 72 hours.

Teacher Office Hours

Students can make an appointment to Zoom in and receive help from their teachers from 3:10pm to 3:40pm Tuesday through Friday. Our GOMS teachers are ready and available during this time to help all students with any questions or concerns they may have regarding our curriculum.

GOMS Library

The GOMS library will be opening this **Wednesday**, **October 7th** for all students to check out books, chromebooks, and have a place to work on homework. **The library hours will go from 8:15am to 3:00pm.**Student numbers will be limited within the library to follow our RUSD COVID-19 protocols. Students will be free to use the library during the morning, at lunch, and after school to complete homework, check out books and chromebooks. Please be sure to follow all social distancing protocols while using the library.

RUSD Reopening Guidelines

Please look over the document that was sent out via email about the <u>RUSD Reopening Guidelines</u>. Please note that all students and staff must wear face coverings while on campus during hybrid learning.

"In order to comply with this guidance, schools must exclude students from campus if they are not exempt from wearing a face covering under CDPH guidelines and refuse to wear one provided by the school."- pg. 6 of RUSD Reopening Guide.

Masks

All staff must wear a face covering at school when physical distancing is not possible. All students must wear a face covering at school except when eating lunch. All students must wear a face covering on the bus, unless exempt. Face coverings will be provided to staff (face shields as appropriate). Face coverings are available upon request for students. Please let us know if you have any questions regarding the wearing of a mask.

Synchronous/Asynchronous/Enrichment Learning

We would like to give you a reminder about how asynchronous and synchronous learning looks during the hybrid model.

- Asynchronous instruction: Providing instruction or communication to students without meeting at the same place and/or at the same time. Examples include discussion boards, e-mail communication, self-paced learning modules, or providing recorded videos or lectures.
- Synchronous Instruction: Delivering instruction and communication to students in real time. An example of synchronous instruction would include in class instruction.

The asynchronous learning at home will take different approaches according to the teacher and what they assign. That being said, students will be asked to check in with their enrichment teacher during their enrichment period each day. This will be the only time that they are required to check in with a teacher on their asynchronous days. During the enrichment time students can ask questions of their teacher or receive help on assignments. Work/assignments/flipped classes will be posted on Schoology for asynchronous days by each teacher. These work/assignments/flipped classes will take different varied forms according to each teacher.

Teachers will have office hours at the end of each day where students can make an appointment to receive more help in their class. Please contact any teacher to make an appointment during their 3:10 to 3:40 pm office hours.

Hybrid A/B Groups

Students will be divided into "A" and "B" groups that will have synchronous learning on campus one day and asynchronous learning at home the other day. **Students will also be required to check in with their enrichment class on the days in which they receive asynchronous instruction at home.** The "A" grouping of students will be completing synchronous or in school learning on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The "B" grouping of students will be completing synchronous or in school learning on Wednesday's and Friday's. Our "A" and "B" groups will be alternating Mondays at school and at home.
