Good afternoon,

RUSD is working hard to keep our Zoom meetings secure for all of our participants. We have decided to make a few changes to keep our meetings as safe as possible from people who would join and interrupt meetings.

Students will need to authenticate their RUSD Zoom Account by the end of the day this Friday, September 4th in order to be able to log into any Zoom meetings on Tuesday, September 8th. It is imperative that each of our students authenticate their RUSD Zoom account.

Security Changes to Zoom meetings:

Name Changes: For security reasons, we have removed the ability for students to change their names on our Zoom platform. We are aware of the desire our students have to be called by the name they choose, but name changes will go through a confidential process before being changed. This policy will take effect once students have authenticated their accounts.

Authenticated Participants Only: In order for students to be allowed into any Rocklin Unified School District Zoom meeting they must use their authenticated Rocklin Unified School District Zoom accounts (<u>rocklinusd.org</u> email address) to attend the RUSD Zoom meeting.

Additionally, emails have been sent to all students (last Friday) who have not yet properly authenticated through their @rocklinusd.org account. These emails come from Zoom but may have one of our IT staff email addresses included in the body of the text.
