This announcement was made during the end of seventh period today via our loudspeaker system. We know that this is very disappointing for all stakeholders involved with our Neon Dance, but the unpredictable nature of winds, smoke, and AQI numbers have forced this decision.

However, we are extremely happy to announce that we have rescheduled our dance for October 1st. We were able to quickly contact our DJ and secure this date for our Neon Dance so hold onto those tickets! We will be happy to refund any dance tickets for students if this date is not available to them.

We would like to take a moment to share some important information regarding the Parent Falcon Club (PFC) as well as invite you to participate in our collective efforts to support GOMS teachers, staff, and students.



Our mission is to secure financial resources for the school to create better educational experiences for our children, promote good citizenship, and support the teaching staff. We are able to fund many GOMS programs including student clubs, academy programs,

technology needs, and more because of your support. We had a phenomenal membership drive (\$10,580 raised, a big thank you to these Falcon parents!) which will all go towards GOMS programs.

This year, we would like to bring to your attention several initiatives that we feel would greatly improve the GOMS community:

- Student Learning and Recovery programs Over the last year or two, many students have "lost" knowledge and are not at the level we would like them to be due to multiple factors. Teachers have requested funds to provide school related necessities and other items for support and encouragement.
- Broadcast Equipment The Broadcast Club produces morning announcements for the school which are also posted to the GOMS school website for parents. The previous broadcast equipment was cobbled together from donations and had to be discarded this year due to old age, nothing could be salvaged. New broadcast equipment would allow students to develop hands-on skills that they can take to high school. Both Rocklin and Whitney High have great broadcast programs and with new equipment, our students can hit the ground running in either high school. The broadcast equipment would also be used by other groups to record other campus events.
- Stage Lights and Curtains GOMS has a stage which is used by drama, choir and band classes and clubs. The lights and curtains are original from when the school opened in 1999. The stage lights overheat, which can cause bulbs to shatter and are a safety hazard. The curtains show signs of wear and tear. Replacing both of these will allow performances to continue safely.
- Technology The Bring Your Own Device program has been very successful. We are glad many parents are able to provide devices for their children. It's a great investment in your child's education and will get much use for many years! For families unable to purchase Chromebooks for their children (especially over the past year or two), GOMS provides devices for these students. There is a continuous need for more Chromebooks and to replace those that have worn out with use and or become obsolete over time.
