IMPORTANT ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

GOMS would like to remind all parents that students not attending GOMS activities are expected to be in attendance. Every student who is not counted in first period attendance is deemed as absent. RUSD loses over 100 dollars per student per day of student absence. This money goes to fund all of our programs and activities at every school in RUSD. Please make every effort to have your student attend school, even if they are not attending one of our activities.

The following are required to participate in the Eighth Grade SunSplash Trip and Promotion Dance:

- ☐ Maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA with no more than one “NM” during the second semester;
- ☐ Maintain a minimum of 80 merits during fourth quarter;
- ☐ Have all fines and fees paid.

Students must have all fines paid & textbooks turned in by May 26, 2023 to participate in end of the year activities.

Promotion Dance Tickets: Tickets are \$15.00 and will be on sale in student homerooms May 17 – May 24. Ticket price includes entertainment, decorations, and refreshments. Make checks payable to GOMS. Students must pre-purchase a ticket to the dance as **there will not be tickets sold at the door**. Only eighth grade Granite Oaks Middle School students with tickets will be admitted to the dance. Students must present their Granite Oaks ID at the door.

Dress Code for 8th Grade Promotion Dance (Theme: “Adventure Awaits!”)

The 8th grade promotion dance is not a formal event. Therefore, students may not arrive in a limousine or wear formal attire (i.e. tuxedos and formal gowns). The RUSD student dress code will be enforced during the end of the year promotion dance. Students dressed inappropriately will not be admitted to the dance. All school behavior rules apply.

SunSplash Tickets: Normal start time for students - students report to homeroom at normal start time 8:00am. Tickets are \$45.00 and will be on sale in student homerooms May 17-24. Ticket price includes transportation, pizza lunch, all day drinks and admission to the park (outside food and drink is not allowed at the park). Make checks payable to **GOMS**. Season tickets will not be accepted on this day. Parents are responsible to pick up students at Granite Oaks at 4:45 p.m. Students **MUST** ride the return bus back to Granite Oaks, unless a parent/guardian checks them out with the teacher in charge. Parents may not pick up other students.

If your student is participating in both activities, you may send in cash or write one check to GOMS for \$60.00.

If your student is attending one or both activities, complete the attached Permission and Medical forms and return no later than May 24th to the student's homeroom teacher.

All sales are final and refunds will only be issued if a student is ineligible to attend or if there is a medical note from a doctor.
