PARENT/GUARDIAN NOTIFICATION LETTER FOR GRADES 7-12 COMPREHENSIVE SEXUAL HEALTH AND HIV PREVENTION EDUCATION The California Healthy Youth Act: EDUCATION CODE §§ 51930-51939

Dear Parent/Guardian:

California state law, the California Healthy Youth Act, requires that comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education be provided to students at least once in middle school and once in high school starting in grade 7. **Rocklin Unified School District students in grade 7 and 9 will be provided this instruction.**

Underlying this course, is the following philosophy that guides the teacher and curriculum:

The Rocklin Unified School District Comprehensive Sexual Health/HIV Prevention Education will present age appropriate, factual information based on current scientific evidence which empowers the student to follow a course of abstinence and other healthy sexual attitudes and behaviors, and recognizes the family as the primary provider of sex education.

Instruction must encourage students to communicate with parents, guardians or other trusted adults about human sexuality. Instruction must be medically accurate, age-appropriate and inclusive of all students. It must include the following:

- Information about HIV and other sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including transmission, FDA approved methods to prevent HIV and STIs, and treatment
- Information that abstinence is the only certain way to prevent unintended pregnancy and HIV and other STIs, and information about the value of delaying sexual activity
- Discussion about social views of HIV and AIDS
- Information about accessing resources for sexual and reproductive health care
- Information about pregnancy, including FDA approved prevention methods, pregnancy outcomes, prenatal care, and the newborn safe surrender law
- Information about sexual orientation and gender, including the harm of negative gender stereotypes
- Information about healthy relationships and avoiding unhealthy behaviors and situations

Note: After previewing the curriculum and/or speaking with staff, if you <u>do not</u> wish your student to participate in Comprehensive Sexual Health/HIV Prevention Education, you must return the section below, signed by you, indicating you do not give permission by February 28, 2023.

If the section below is not filled out completely your child will participate in the district-adopted curriculum.

This form does NOT need to be returned if your child is allowed to participate in the district-adopted curriculum.

California Junior Scholarship Federation



Attention 7th & 8th Grade Scholars

The Granite Oaks chapter of the California Junior Scholarship Federation (CJSF) is now accepting applications for spring membership. The purpose of CJSF is to foster high standards, service and citizenship for middle school students. To qualify for CJSF, applicants must meet the following:

- 1. All grades earned from the fall 2022 semester must be "C" or better.
- Eligibility is based on CJSF's point system. To be eligible, a student must have at least twice the number of points as classes. An "A" = 3 points, a "B" = 1 point, and a "C" = 0 points. Enrichment, Leadership, and P.E. do not count as academic subjects.
- Advanced Math 7 Classes: "A" = 3 points, a "B" = 2 points, and a "C" = 0 points.
- 4. Applicants must have maintained 85 or more merits throughout the two previous quarters.
- 5. Applicants should be willing to participate in volunteer service activities for their school and community while members of CJSF. The minimum requirement is 2 hours of school service per semester.

Applications can be picked up in Student Services or in rooms C5 (8th gr.) and C8 (7th gr.).
