Granite Oaks Middle School Student Named Winner of 2023 Placer County Spelling Bee

Champion Advances to California Spelling Bee on May 13

ROCKLIN, Calif. – March 22, 2023 – The Rocklin Unified School District (RUSD) is elated to announce that Granite Oaks Middle School's Rohitjeyan Kulanthaivel is the champion in this year's Placer County Spelling Bee - Junior High Category. Additionally, also from Granite Oaks Middle School, Audrey Tzeng is the 1st Runner Up in the same category.

Organized by the Placer County Office of Education, approximately

250 students in grades four through eight competed in a written examination in February, with the top 10 scorers moving on to the oral competition on March 15 at the Rocklin Events Center.

The winners of the Junior High and the Elementary categories (from Eureka Union School District) will represent Placer County at the California State Spelling Bee, scheduled to take place on Saturday, May 13, 2023 in San Joaquin County.
