We are proud to announce that we will be hosting the One Pill Can Kill Assembly at GOMS on Wednesday, April 19th. This assembly is sponsored by Placer County and addresses the dangers of Fentanyl use. Fentanyl poisoning has killed dozens of Placer County residents since 2019. Our assembly delves into how Fentanyl use leads to tragedy for families such as the Didier family here in Rocklin.

Placer county also gives parents a podcast dedicated to the dangers of Fentanyl. In the "One Pill Can Kill" podcast, parents can take a deeper look at the epidemic of fake pills and its impacts on our community, what you can do to keep your family safe, and how Placer County health, law enforcement and education agencies are working to address it. The "One Pill Can Kill" podcast is presented by the Placer County Health and Human Services Department, Sheriff's Office and District Attorney's Office.
