Rocklin Unified Partners with Care Solace for Mental Health Care Coordination

Dear Rocklin Unified Students, Families, and Staff,

The Rocklin Unified School District (RUSD) is committed to the safety and well-being of all students, staff, and families in order to foster a healthy learning environment. This includes mental health. The purpose of this communication is to inform you of a new mental health coordination platform to assist in receiving an additional layer of care for our community.

Care Solace helps individuals find mental health care providers and substance use treatment centers. Their Care Companion™ team is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and 365 days per year to quickly connect you to carefully verified providers in your community.

Students, staff, and families may access Care Solace services in two ways:

- **Call (888) 515-0595** at any time. Support is available in 200+ languages. A dedicated Care Companion™ will help you every step of the way to research options, secure appointments, and follow up to make sure it is a good fit.
- For an anonymous search, answer a few questions to get matched with an extensive list of care providers at www.caresolace.com/rocklinusd.

Care Solace is now available for use at no cost to you. They will connect you with providers accepting all medical insurances including Medicaid, Medicare, and sliding scale options for those without insurance. All information entered on the Care Solace tool is completely confidential and securely stored.

This service is an optional resource available by choice and is not mandatory to use. Care Solace is not an emergency response service or mental health services provider. In the event of a life threatening emergency, please call 9-1-1 or the National Suicide Hotline 9-8-8.

This complimentary resource is provided by Rocklin Unified and available to all students, staff, and their families. Rocklin Unified is a recipient of a grant through the City of Rocklin's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), which contributes to our mental health supports, including Care Solace.
